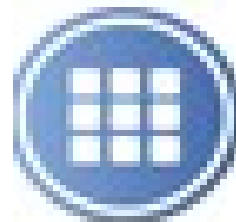
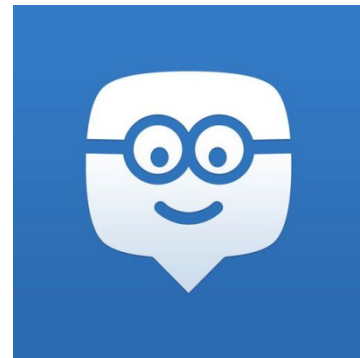

What is Social Media?

1. Social media embraces web-based and mobile-based technologies to facilitate interactive communication between organisations, communities and individuals.
2. Social media is the collective of online communication channels dedicated to community-based input, interaction, content-sharing and collaboration.
3. Forms of electronic communication (as Web sites for social networking and microblogging) through which users create online communities to share information, ideas, personal messages, and other content (such as videos)
4. Social Media is the future of communication, a countless array of internet based tools and platforms that increase and enhance the sharing of information. This new form of media makes the transfer of text, photos, audio, video, and information in general increasingly fluid among internet users.

The social media map provides a visual summary of some of the most common types of social media platforms, and their purposes.

What is Pinterest?

- An online pinboard where users create and manage a collection of visual material (images, videos, infographics and links to websites).
- Content is organised in boards which are based on particular themes (e.g. topic-based quotes, interesting articles/videos for students, etc).
- All the resources are well organised at one place and easily accessible.
- Boards can be created in cooperation with other teachers/students.

- We can browse the already existing pins/pinboards and repin some stuff that is relevant for us
- Teachers can share their resources with their colleagues or/and students

What is Symbaloo?


- Symbaloo is a very good tool for making a list of internet sites useful for education and other purposes
